Re: Support for the San Francisco Police Department's (SFPD's) FY 2027 Community Project Funding Request

Dear Speaker Emerita Pelosi,

I write in support of the San Francisco Police Department's (SFPD's) FY 2027 Community Project Funding Request for \$840,000 for 20 new motorcycles in their traffic unit.

SFPD currently maintains a fleet of 49 motorcycles, 45 of which are 10 years old or older. The aging fleet far exceeds the industry standard lifespan of three years for a police motorcycle. Additionally, of the 45 motorcycles, 10 are no longer operational due to catastrophic damage or cost-prohibitive repairs. Instead, they are being used for spare parts.

Since taking office as Mayor, my top priority has been public safety. With these new motorcycles, SFPD will be able to safely navigate the roadway landscape of our city, while meeting critical operational needs to keep the community safe. Motorcycle officers play an essential role in traffic enforcement, at high-profile events such as parades and First Amendment demonstrations, and in providing protective escorts. Given the visibility and importance of these assignments, we cannot afford mechanical failures that leave events understaffed or officers at risk.

This funding will allow SFPD to replace 20 aging motorcycles, which will directly benefit the City and County of San Francisco. By equipping officers with a reliable and updated motorcycle fleet, we will enhance SFPD's operational capacity during high-profile events and improve public safety.

As such, I write in support of the San Francisco Police Department's FY 2027 Community Project Funding request. Thank you for your continued leadership and consideration.
