The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the nine-county Bay Area. Our current long-range Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and regional Sustainable Communities Strategy, Plan Bay Area 2050, was adopted in October 2021.

MTC submits this letter of support for Transbay Joint Powers Authority's request for community project funding for \$1 million for the Wayfinding Improvements at the Salesforce Transit Center Project. The project will improve wayfinding at the transit center to allow transit riders to efficiently navigate the multimodal facility and access the transportation connections and services it offers.
