Thank you for your work on the House Appropriations committee. I am respectfully requesting funding to support Home for Good in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the San Francisco Department of Disability and Aging Services and is located at 1650 Mission Street, San Francisco, California 94103. The funding would be used to support Home For Good: Aging in Place for High-Acuity Veterans, a scalable, community-based care model that embeds enhanced on-site and roving staff to help aging and high-acuity residents of permanent supportive housing remain stably housed and age in place with dignity. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the program will support 125 formerly homeless veterans in San Francisco maintain stable housing, improve health, reduce reliance on local emergency services and reduce premature exits to skilled nursing facilities. The model design can be shared with all permanent supportive housing providers to adopt effective, cost-saving practices for increasing housing stability and wellness.
