Thank you for your work on the House Appropriations committee. I am respectfully requesting funding for Re-entry Hub: Senior Ex-Offender Program Community and Rehabilitation Center in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Bayview Hunters Point Multipurpose Senior Services Inc., located at 1706 Yosemite Street, San Francisco, CA 94124. The funding would be used for building repairs to the Senior Ex-Offender Program (SEOP) re-entry hub. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the program helps individuals 50 and older being released from jails and prisons back into the community.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes described in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
