**Re: Support for the San Francisco Public Library's FY 2027 Community Project Funding Request**

Dear Speaker Emerita Pelosi,

I write in support of the San Francisco Public Library's FY 2027 Community Project Funding Request for \$1.75 million for Civic Grove at Fulton Plaza.

Fulton Plaza is located in San Francisco's Civic Center, sitting between San Francisco's Main Public Library, Asian Art Museum, UN Plaza, and Civic Center Plaza. People move through the plaza on their way to or from public transit, or before or after visiting one of the many surrounding civic buildings, art institutions, or small businesses.

The Civic Grove at Fulton Plaza would transform this space into a permanent, flexible civic infrastructure offering that could support performances, cultural events, and community gatherings. The project would install stage infrastructure, integrated utilities such as power and lighting, sound capacity, and movable landscape elements, while simultaneously reducing the need for repeated temporary installations for public events and the weekly Heart of the City Farmers' Market.

By investing in durable infrastructure that supports programming and lowers operational barriers to community activation, this project advances the City's goal of cultivating sustainable models for arts and cultural venues while strengthening San Francisco's creative ecosystem.

As such, I write in support of the San Francisco Public Library's FY 2027 Community Project Funding Request for \$1.75 million for Civic Grove at Fulton Plaza. Thank you for your continued leadership and consideration.
