I write in support of the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department's FY 2027 Community Project Funding Request for \$3.2 million for acquisition of 989 Post.

Ensuring that San Franciscans have access to local parks, trails, and open spaces is essential for mental and physical well-being. Parks and open spaces, especially in a city as dense as San Francisco, are an important place for kids to play, adults to socialize, and seniors to gather. It is crucial that we keep our parks accessible, maintained, and up to date.

989 Post Street is a long time vacant commercial property in San Francisco's Tenderloin neighborhood, with limited access to parks and open space. The 7,653-square-foot site includes a former one-story commercial building and a gated parking lot, presenting a rare opportunity to transform an underutilized property into a community-serving park. The surrounding neighborhood has a high density of children, families, and seniors, who would benefit greatly from a new park. Acquiring and redeveloping this site would allow the City to remediate a contaminated property while addressing long-standing scarcity of open space in one of San Francisco's most vibrant neighborhoods, creating a safe and welcoming place for recreation, respite, and community connection.
